Keep the status quo in Mithian.

Mithian is now a fast rat-run, it needs some control.

Traffic speed in Mithian.

Slow down!! Especially on the approach to the gravel pit junction.

Invest in the drains before any more development.

Seasonal speed limits to make it safer for summer visitors (pedestrians) around Trevellas / Barkla Shop.

More dog bins, to stop dog walkers leaving bags of dog mess in the hedge.

Mithian is becoming a speeding rat run. Need 20mph limit and sleeping policemen.

Lack of facilities for older children in the parish. Playing fields, skate park, School playing fields are unused after school – what a waste.

But no street lights. Please maintain dark skies.
