Big problems now with sewerage. Banns Vale gets raw sewage when it rains heavily.

I attended the original meeting in the Social Club where the plans were put forward to George Eustice. Now if originally it was to flood the school (and the doctors' surgery) and drain resources what has Mount Hawke achieved?

Mount Hawke needs more leisure facilities, more sports. Too little use is made of the Social Club. The "community" lacks an aliveness.

Roads – small and too fast already. Drainage and run-off. Schools and surgeries – can they support this?

Think permaculture.

Transport – Bus needs to start earlier. Cannot get to Truro central by 9am. Coming back, last bus to Porthtowan 5.50pm. New industrial estates by A30 will have to be reached by car.

There is quaint and there is sleepy/underused.

There is insufficient parking.

New developments should be required to provide alternative energy ? Communal water/heating systems. Cars and traffic should be separate from pedestrians.

Traffic?

Road lights?

There should be a traffic warden or traffic parking control measures to stop cars parking on double yellow lines, blocking flow of traffic, public transport and residential driveways.

Can we come off-grid in effect by solar and wind. More community owned.

These developments give carrots. i.e. parking areas that never come about.

Not enough parking + Doctors' surgery only open 4 mornings, can they do more? No transport - evenings. There has already been trouble with sewers.

Need to slow traffic down coming through Mount Hawke.
